Sub: Restrictions for COVID containment- regarding

Government Order No. 37-JK (DMRRR) of 2021. Dated: 05.06.2021

- Whereas a detailed review of the current COVID situation in Jammu and Kashmir was conducted by the Chief Secretary, J&K, with the Financial Commissioner, Health and Medical Education; Divisional Commissioner, Jammu / Kashmir and other officers, on 04-06-2021; and
- 2) Whereas the above said review was conducted on an overall assessment of the situation pertaining to the spread of COVID-19 in Jammu and Kashmir, particularly focusing on the following parameters –
  - a. Total weekly new case load.
  - b. Total positivity rate.
  - c. Bed Occupancy.
  - d. Case fatality rate.
  - e. Vaccination coverage of targeted population.
- 3) Whereas it was felt that while significant improvement has been made by a couple of districts in respect of the above parameters, there is however a need to continue with existing COVID containment measures to contain any further spike in cases of infection.
- 4) Now therefore, the State Executive Committee, in exercise of the powers conferred up on it under section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, hereby orders that the guidelines / instructions on COVID containment in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir already notified vide Government Orders 35 and 36 JK (DMRRR) of 2021 dated 29-05-2021 shall continue to remain in force till further orders. However, the following relaxations are granted to a few activities only in districts Poonch and Kishtwar on account of significant improvement shown by them in the above-mentioned parameters –



- a) Barber Shops, Saloons and Parlors are permitted to open on four days in a week (except on Saturdays and Sundays) as per the days notified by concerned DCs.
- b) Standalone shops, Outdoor bazaars and Outdoor shopping complexes are also permitted to open on four days (except on Saturday and Sundays) as per the days notified by concerned DCs.
- 5) It is further ordered that the wholesale trade of Liquor shall be permitted to operate on 5 days in a week (except Saturdays and Sundays) in the entire UT.
- 6) The District Magistrates shall strictly ensure that there is full compliance to COVID appropriate behavior and defaulters are firmly dealt with under relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act and the Indian Penal Code.
