I. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>

1. Age : As per UGC Regulations regarding appointment of Assistant Professors. Teachers who retired from Colleges/ Universities will also be considered subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall be 70 years as on 01.01.2023.

2. **Qualification**: As per UGC norms.

3. **Remuneration**: ₹1750/- per day subject to a maximum of ₹43,750/- per month for UGC qualified hands (In the absence of UGC qualified hands, non UGC candidates will be considered with a remuneration of ₹1600/- per day subject to a maximum of ₹40,000/- per month)

II. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The initial period of appointment is for one academic year which is extendable for another two more years based on the annual performance report.

2. For the post reserved for a particular community or a group of communities as mentioned above, only the persons belonging to that community or group of communities need to apply. Reservation rotation is specified in serial order against the vacancies of each School.

3. Applicants for post under community reservation quota shall submit community certificate and Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued this year by the authorities concerned, those who apply for EWS reservation should bring EWS certificate (State Govt.Criteria) at the time of interview. Non Creamy Layer Certificate need not be furnished by applicants for the post reserved for SC and ST communities.

4. Natives of states other than Kerala need not apply for the post notified exclusively under community reservation quota.

5. Degree obtained from Universities/ institutions outside the state of Kerala shall be accompanied by equivalency/eligibility certificate obtained from this University.

6. The Guest Faculty recruitment will be strictly in adherence with the provisions envisaged in the University Order No. 6853/AD A5/2021/MGU dated 10.12.2021
