Subject: Final Selection List-cum-Allocation of Cadres & Departments for remaining Class-IV Posts under the provisions of the Jammu & Kashmir Appointment to Class-IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020, advertised vide Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020- Filling up of reserved posts reg.

Sir,

In reference to the above captioned subject, it is to inform that six (06) vacancies, from among the posts earmarked for the Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwDBs), sub-category of Low Vision, in the Final Selection List notified for the Class-IV posts vide No.SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/6202-09 dated 06.10.2022 and forwarded to the General Administration Department vide letter No.SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/6273-78 dated 18.10.2022 were kept *Reserved*, for want of a clarification with regard to the suitability of the candidates figuring against these posts.

These candidates, who were otherwise figuring against these reserved posts, approached the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh in case bearing WP(C) PIL No. 29/2020 titled National Federation of Blind V/S UT of J&K & Ors. The Hon'ble High Court passed the following directions in the matter:

"...Accordingly, we direct the respondents to appoint the aforesaid 6 (six) blind candidates with the observation that their appointment will be provisional and will be subject to outcome of instant the writ petition. Their appointments will, of course, be subject to verification of the relevant documents by the appointing authority..."

Accordingly, the matter was taken up with the General Administration Department, which, vide letter No. GAD-MTGORBIV/290/2022 (7071886) dated 08.05.2024, forwarded the opinion of Department of Law, Justice & Parliamentary Affairs and advised the Board to consider the aforesaid candidates as suitable for these Class-IV posts.

Further, the matter was examined in light of the advice of General Administration Department/opinion of Department of Law Justice Parliamentary Affairs and placed in the Board for consideration. The Board, in its 272nd meeting held on 27.05.2024, decided to fill the six posts, which have been kept reserved for these candidates in the Final Selection List notified for the Class-IV posts, advertised vide Notification No. 02 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020. Accordingly, vide Notification No.



JKSSB-ADM/114/2022-03 (E-7062939) dated 04.06.2024, the aforesaid posts were filled up (copy enclosed).

Accordingly, I am directed to forward herewith the recommendations in respect of six (06) candidates, as per **Annexure-A** to this communication, for further necessary action at your end.

It is further submitted that the document verification/ scrutiny conducted by the Board is limited to the extent of establishing physical possession of Category/Degree and ascertaining genuineness/validity etc. or otherwise of the same and recognition status of the Institution, shall be responsibility of the Indenting Department/appointing authority.


Besides, the Certificates produced by the candidates, on the basis of which they have been assigned additional weight-age, may also be verified from the issuing authorities as the final merit has been determined on the basis of the written score and additional weight-age claimed by the candidates.

Further, the eligibility of the candidates in respect of the Minimum and Maximum qualification for these posts (10th and 12th respectively) has been accepted on the basis of the self-declaration of the candidates and the appointing authorities may satisfy themselves on this account before issuing appointment orders.

It is further requested that in case any certificate/document, during the course of verification, turns out to be fake/fictitious, the Board may kindly be kept posted and appropriate criminal proceedings against such candidates may kindly be initiated.

These recommendations are subject to any ongoing inquiry and also outcome of writ petition(s), if any, pending before any competent Court of Law.
