- Q.3 Examine the plot structure of the play *Doctor Faustus*.
- Q.4 Analyze the relationships between Volpone and his victims and explain how these interactions reveal the themes of deception and manipulation in the play *Volpone*.

- Q.4 How does Faustus' pride contribute to his downfall in the play *Dr. Faustus*.

- Q.2 Discuss the language and tone of *Epithalamion*, particularly in relation to the joyous celebration of the wedding.

- Q.4 How does Satan's speech in Book 1 of *Paradise Lost* serve as an explanation of his character and motivations?
