E- GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:


1. All the relevant information / updates shall be uploaded on the University website. The candidates are advised to remain in touch with the University website <http://www.cusrinagar.edu.in>. To notify the same in newspapers shall not be obligatory on the University.
2. Candidates seeking reservation under different reserved categories are required to submit certificate on the format prescribed by the competent authority.
3. It is the responsibility of the applicant to assess his/her own eligibility to the post(s) for which he/she is applying in accordance with the Advertisement. If, at any stage, it is found that the applicant is not eligible as per the prescribed eligibility criteria, which could not be detected at the time of selection for whatever reason; his/her candidature / appointment shall be liable to be cancelled / terminated immediately.
4. A candidate, if applying for more than one post, should submit separate prescribed form for each post with separate processing fee receipt.
5. The number of posts shown above may vary during the recruitment process. The university reserves the right not to fill any/ all posts advertised and to reject any/all application without assigning any reason.
6. Applications that are not in prescribed form / without relevant supporting enclosures shall be summarily be rejected. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
7. The appointment to the notified positions is provisional and subject to the verification of documents/claims through proper channels. If the verification at any point of time reveals that the claim of the candidate/s belonging to a particular category is false, his/her services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reason(s) and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under the provisions in Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita for production of false certificates;
8. The eligibility of candidates will be determined as on the last date fixed for submission of online application forms;
9. The person employed on regular employment in Government and Semi-Government Organizations, Public Sector, autonomous bodies of J&K Government or Govt. of India must apply through proper channel. In such cases, the candidates are asked to send an advance copy so as to reach before the stipulated deadline. In such cases, the applicants are required to bring No Objection Certificate / Copy of forwarding letter from his/her employer at the time of appearing Screening Test / Personal Interview.
10. No disciplinary/ vigilance case should be pending against the applicants working in any Govt./ Semi- Govt./ Autonomous Organizations. The applicants are requested to submit correct information in the application form.
11. Age of superannuation shall be as per the Jammu & Kashmir University Norms;
12. All the appointees including the in-service candidates shall be governed by the New Pension System/Scheme (NPS) introduced by the Government of J&K.

13. The University reserves the right:
 - a. To withdraw the advertisement either partly or wholly at any time without assigning any reason to that effect;
 - b. To fill or not to fill up some or all the posts advertised for any reason whatsoever;
 - c. To increase/decrease the number of posts at the time of selection and make appointments accordingly;
 - d. Amendments/Corrigendum, if any, in the advertisement notice shall be published on the university website.
14. Cluster University of Srinagar will not be responsible for loss of any communication due to wrong address provided by the candidate or unsuccessful transaction through Payment Gateway etc.
15. A valid e-mail ID and Mobile Number are mandatory for submitting application online and should be kept active till final selection. The Institute will send call letter for written test/interview to the registered e-mail ID. No correspondence will be sent by post/courier.
16. The persons with benchmark disability (PWD), as indicated against various item(s) in the vacancy details, can apply to the respective posts even if the post is not reserved for them but has been identified as suitable. However, such candidates will be considered for selection to such post by general standard of merit. Persons suffering from not less than 40% of relevant disability shall alone be eligible for the benefit of reservation and other relaxations as permissible under the reservation policy of the UT. The disability certificate must be issued by medical board constituted either by Central or State government, no other certificates will be accepted.
17. Any addendum/corrigendum and related notifications will be published at the university website: www.cusrinagar.edu.in only. Applicants are advised to regularly visit the university website for any update/notification. No separate communication will be sent to any individual candidate.
18. Legal disputes, if any, with Cluster University of Srinagar, the jurisdiction will be restricted within Srinagar city only.
19. The University shall retain data of online application of shortlisted/non-shortlisted candidates for up to six months only after the date of completion of the recruitment process.
20. Candidates are requested to bring all relevant certificates and testimonials at the time when called during interview (Original and one set of self-attested copies).
21. Mere fulfilment of the required qualifications and experience etc., does not entitle a candidate to be called for screening test and / or personal interview. The university reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates for screening test and personal interview to a reasonable limit, on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than those prescribed in this advertisement and as per merit decided by the university.
22. The selection for the post Assistant Registrar shall be made on the basis of the written test followed by interview. The weightage of the written test and interview shall be 80/100 (80%) and 20/100 (20%) (written test-80 marks + interview- 20 marks Total=100 marks) and for Assistant Librarian the selection shall be made as per UGC guidelines.
23. For PwD candidates extra time will be given in the written test for shortlisting purpose as per UGC norms.
24. The syllabus for written test shall be notified separately and shall be made available on the official website of the university www.cusrinagar.edu.in
25. The service conditions including mode of appointment shall be governed in accordance with the Srinagar & Jammu Cluster Universities Act, 2016 and Statutes.
26. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written test / interview.

F- GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Applicants are required to apply only through online recruitment portal of the university website: <https://cusrinagar.edu.in>.
2. Before applying for a post, candidates are advised to satisfy themselves about their eligibility.
3. In-service candidates shall route their applications through proper channel which should essentially reach the office by or before the conduct of the interviews. However, they must submit an advance copy of the print out of the online application form before the last date.
4. Applications not accompanied by following supporting and self-attested documents shall be rejected summarily;
 - i. High School certificate from a recognized board;
 - ii. Marks sheet and degree of graduation;
 - iii. Marks sheet and degree of post-graduation;
 - iv. Certificate of NET/JRF/SET/SLET/CSIR etc (if applicable);
 - v. MPhil /PhD degree certificate (if applicable);
 - vi. Experience certificates wherever applicable;
 - vii. Category certificate, if any, duly authenticated by the concerned authority;
 - viii. NOC from parent department (for in-service candidates)
 - ix. Any other certificate /documents as required under qualifications
