Candidates are directed to submit filled application form (Annexure-I) along with all relevant documents in Room No 229, Department of Radiation Oncology SKIMS, Srinagar upto 4th October 2025. Applications submitted after cutoff date or with incomplete documents will not be entertained.

Date of Interview for the shortlisted candidates will be communicated separately.

The terms & conditions for the post are as follows: -


1. The posts will be filled up purely on temporary basis.
2. The appointment can be terminated with one-month notice from either side without assigning any reason

Since the post is purely temporary, the selected candidate will have to give an undertaking duly attested by a first class Judicial Magistrate that he/ she will abide by the terms and conditions of engagement laid down for the project and not make any claim for regular appointment or continuation of his/her services beyond the stipulated term. Moreover, the undertaking must mention that the candidate will not approach any Honorable court/ Tribunal for filing writ application or any other proceedings seeking therein the continuation of engagement term beyond the stipulated tenure.
