Subject: **Conduct of the 3rd/Mop-up Round of Counselling/Submission of Online Preferences by the eligible candidates for admission to 10th-Based Paramedical Diploma Courses (FMPHW/MMPHW)-2026.**

Reference: i) Notification No. 078-BOPEE of 2026 Dated 04-06-2026.

NOTIFICATION No. 084-BOPEE of 2026 Dated 18-06-2026

Pursuant to Notification No. 078-BOPEE of 2026 Dated 04-06-2026, the Board has received a shortfall **on the online joining module of the J&K BOPEE Portal** from various Government/Private Colleges of the UT of J&K/Ladakh for admission to 10th-based Paramedical Diploma Courses (FMPHW/MMPHW). To fill up these shortfall seats along with the seats which have become available due to non-joining, resignation/surrender or remain vacant during the second round of counselling, it is hereby notified for the information of all concerned candidates that the Board shall conduct the 3rd/Mop-up Round of Online (Upgradation/Allotment) counselling w.e.f. 19-06-2026 **(11:30 A.M. onwards) to 23-06-2026 (Midnight).**

The following candidates shall be eligible to participate in the Third/Mop-up Round of Online (Upgradation/Allotment) Counselling:

- i) Candidates who did not get any seat in the first/second round.
- ii) Candidates who have been allotted a seat during the first/second round and have joined the Institute.
- iii) Candidates who have been allotted a seat in the first round and have not joined the institute, and candidates who resigned after joining up to the last date of joining of the first round, will be eligible to participate in the third round for all courses /institutions, subject to availability of seats.
- iv) Candidates who have been allotted a seat during the second round and have not joined the said Institution will not be eligible to opt for the said course in the said institution in the third round. However, they will be eligible to participate in counselling/admissions for other courses in the same institution and all courses in other institutions. They will also be eligible to participate in counselling/admissions in the mop-up round for all courses/institutions, subject to the availability of seat(s).

- v) Candidates who have cancelled their admission by or before the last date of admission of the allotted seat of Second Round at the Institution, will not be eligible to opt for the said course in the said institution in the third round. However, they will be eligible to participate in counselling/admissions for other courses in the same institution and all courses in other institutions. They will also be eligible to participate in counselling/admissions in the mop-up round for all courses/institutions, subject to the availability of seat(s).
- vi) **The eligible candidates who have qualified for the 10th-Based Paramedical Diploma (FMPHW/MMPHW) Courses Common Entrance Test (CET)-2026 and have not participated during the First/Second Round of counselling are also eligible for this round of counselling.**

Important Note:

- 1. In this round, firstly, only vacant seats shall be filled from respective categories as from where shortfall has been received i.e. the seats left-out by the OM candidates during the 1st/2nd round shall be allotted to the OM candidates and those left by the category candidates shall be allotted to the category candidates based on merit-cum-preferences which will be followed by mop-up round based on preferences already filled by the candidate for 3rd/mop-up round. Candidates should note that for the Mop-up round, no fresh choices will be invited. The choices filled up for this round of counselling will be considered for the Mop-up round as well. So, the candidates shall fill in the choices/preferences very carefully for this round.**
2. In case any category seat remains vacant even after the upgradation/allotment during 1st /2nd/3rd round, the same shall be de-reserved and filled up from all candidates through online mode of counselling in terms of Proviso to sub-section 2 of section 9 of J&K Reservation Act 2004. However, after conversion of category seats into General Seats, any seat(s) left by Reserved category candidates shall be treated as General/ OM category seats and will be allotted to any category (OM/Reserved) candidate(s) based on merit-cum preferences.
3. The seats in the "OM" which have remained vacant on conclusion of the 1st / 2nd/3rd rounds shall also form part of the seat matrix for the mop-up round and shall be filled up during the process out of all available eligible interested candidates based on merit-cum-preferences. **The seats vacated by the candidate during upgradation in this round shall be filled simultaneously.**
4. The candidates who do not participate in the process of counselling by not filling up of the fresh preference forms shall in no case be considered for allotment of a seat. They shall have no claim whatsoever on any seat filled up by the Board from amongst the

candidates, who participate in the process.

5. The preferences indicated by the candidates during the first/second round of counselling shall be deemed to be cancelled and shall not be applicable for 3rd/mop-up round of counselling. The candidates must submit fresh preferences for the 3rd/mop-up round of counselling. If a candidate does not submit fresh choices/preferences during the choice-filling period, the candidate will not be considered for allotment of a seat during 3rd/mop-up round and will retain the already joined seat, if any.
6. If a seat has been allotted to a candidate and he/she fails to join the Institution within the stipulated time as notified by the Board, the allotted seat shall be treated as cancelled, and his / her claim on the said seat shall cease.
7. **To make the admission process more affordable, the Board has waived the counselling fee for the course vide Notice No. 010-BOPEE of 2026 Dated 23-03-2026.**
8. **Candidates must consider available seats thoroughly and opt for such seats for which they are interested because a seat once allotted cannot be changed. It is made clear that in case the candidate who has been allotted a seat but does not join the allotted institution and/or fails to comply with necessary formalities, his/her admission shall be cancelled, and they will not be eligible for any further round of counselling, if conducted.**
9. Seat matrix shall be uploaded separately as per the schedule referred above, and all the participating/eligible candidates are advised to go through the seat matrix before participating in the counselling process.

The other terms and conditions shall remain the same as notified by the Board in the e-Information Brochure and Notifications/Notices issued from time to time in this regard.
