The School Education Department vide letter No. Edu-Gen/35/2024/35/2024-01(7383282) dated 12.11.2024 and dated 05.12.2024 referred 51 posts (OM=21, RBA= 05, SC= 04, ST-1= 05, ST-2= 05, ALC/IB = 02, OBC= 04, EWS =05) of Lecturer Chemistry in School Education Department to J&K Public Service Commission for selection; and,

These posts were advertised vide Notification No. 07-PSC (DR-P) of 2024 dated 09.12.2024.

The written test was conducted on 12.10.2025 and the result thereof was declared vide Notification No. PSC/Exam/S/2025/61 dated 01.12.2025. 161 candidates were declared to have provisionally qualified the examination for viva-voce.

The Provisional Select List for the post of Lecturer Chemistry in School Education Department vide Notification No. 37-PSC(DR-S) of 2026 dated 19.05.2026, with a stipulation that the selection is provisional, objection if any may be submitted.

4. Mr. Mohammad Muzafar Wani.


Whereas, the objections raised in the representations and their consideration is given here-in-under:

S.No.	Name of the representee	Objection	Remarks/disposal
1	Faizan ul Mukhtar	He has submitted that in chemistry subject have been kept 10, 1.5 and even 11 marks in viva voce. Simultaneously interview was conducted for physics and English subjects and the highest among these subjects for interview is mostly 09 marks with one/two candidates given 9.5 marks, but for chemistry there has been an abnormal trend with candidate given huge marks.	The points awarded by the Interview Board to individual candidate are purely on basis of his/her performance delivered before the Board and strictly in terms of J&K PSC (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021.
2	Muzaffar Ahmad Ganie	He has submitted that the candidate Mr. Mohammad Umar has been selected provisionally under EWS category at S. No. 04. The credentials submitted by the candidate under EWS category require details scrutiny. His family possesses a pucca residential house and a residential property appears to exceed the prescribed limit of 200 square yards under EWS norms. His family own 240 marls apple orchard. The said candidate is availing a a fellowship from CSIR-IIM Sgr. and his brother is reportedly engaged as a contractor. Now he has requested to kindly examined the matter.	The candidate Mr. Mohammad Umar Shah has submitted / uploaded EWS certificate duly issued by competent authority dated 31.12.2024 valid for one year, thus valid as on cut off date.
3	Abida Mohammad	She has submitted that as per the Answer Key released by the JKPC after culmination of written test for	The OMR sheet of the applicant has been verified and it has been found that she secured 87.00 marks

He alleged that the candidate not meeting the mandatory benchmark disability rules, including provision of the Rights of Persons with disabilities Act, 2016. There are credible concerns that the actual disability of the said candidate is significantly lower than what is claimed in the certificate. It is great injustice to genuine PwD candidates and would undermine the integrity, transparency, and credibility of the recruitment process.</p>	<p>Mr. Suhail Ahmed Lone has submitted/uploaded unique Disability ID issued by Competent Authority providing therein disability 50% and of permanent nature.</p>

		In this connection, he has requested that the matter warrants urgent intervention to uphold the rule of law and to ensure that the rights of deserving candidates are not compromised.
