Subject: General Instructions for the Candidates appearing in the Prosecuting Officer (G) (Main) Examination.

### Notice

Dated:-30.06.2026

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It is for the information of all eligible candidates that the Prosecuting Officer (G) (Main) Examination shall be conducted w.e.f. 15.07.2026 as per the date sheet/Schedule already notified vide Notification No.PSC/Exam/2026/12 dated 15.06.2026.

The Admit Cards will be available on 07.07.2026 on the Commission's website <http://www.jkpsc.nic.in>. Those candidates who are not able to download their admit card shall immediately report to the PSC Office, Jammu/Srinagar by or before 13.07.2026. However, in past, cases have been noticed where some candidates have faced difficulty in accessing the server on the last day on account of server overload. The candidates are therefore, advised to take a printout of the admit card well in advance to avoid last minute rush.

The candidature of all the candidates appearing in the Prosecuting Officer (Main) Examination shall be purely provisional subject to further verification of their documents/eligibility at any stage of selection process. Only those candidates should appear in the Main Examination, who fulfills the eligibility criteria prescribed under Notification No.13-PSC (DR-P) of 2025, dated 10.11.2025.

In case eligibility is claimed by misrepresentation, concealment of any material fact(s) or impersonation or fraud, the same shall be cancelled and the candidate shall be liable to disciplinary action by the Commission under norms.

The Commission reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate found ineligible at any stage of Selection Process at which such ineligibility shall be detected.


Further, the candidates are advised to adhere to the following instructions during the examination:-

1. In view of the Security/frisking at the Examination Venue, all the candidates shall report at the Examination Venue at least one & half hour before the commencement of the Examination.

2. Candidates shall carry Admit Card and a valid proof of identity (i.e. Aadhaar Card/ Pan Card/ Driving License/ Passport) and show it to the supervisory staff on duty as and when required/demanded to secure admission to the examination hall.
3. The candidates should read carefully all the instructions mentioned on the admit card and follow it strictly.
4. Do not write anything related or un-related to Examination on the Admit Card
5. Entry to the Examination Venue shall be closed 30 minutes before the commencement of the Examination. Candidates should be seated in the Examination Hall 20 minutes before the commencement of the Examination.
6. The candidates are responsible for the safe custody of the Admit Card and in the event of any other person using this card, the onus to prove that you have not used the services of any impersonator shall lie on him/her.
7. Before entering into the campus of the Examination Centre, the candidate may sure that they are not in possession of the **Mobile Phone/ Smart Watch/ Calculator/ Head Phones/ Bluetooth devices** or any unauthorized/ incriminating material. In case any candidate is found in possession of any unauthorized material including electronic device during the Examination, he/she shall be disqualified for such Examination(s).
8. If any candidate appear at a centre/venue other than the one notified /allotted by the Commission, his/her Question Cum Answer Booklet shall not be evaluated and his/her candidature will be liable to cancellation.
9. The candidate should bring their own instruments viz. blue/ black ball point pen etc. no borrowing or exchange of articles would be allowed in the examination hall.
10. The candidate shall not be permitted to leave the examination hall until expiry of full time.
11. In the Examination hall, the candidate shall be provided a Question Cum Answer Booklet. Candidate read the instructions carefully given on the Question Cum Answer Booklet.
12. The candidate should check that the Question Cum Answer Booklet issued to him/her is not mutilated or damaged or having less number of pages than specified and if so, ask for its replacement immediately.
13. No separate sheet (continuation sheet) shall be provided to any candidate
14. The sheets left blank should be crossed by the candidate himself/herself.

15. The candidate should make their own arrangements of boarding and lodging, PSC shall not defray any TA/ DA expenses.
16. The candidates are advised to keep in mind the weather advisory and reach the examination centre well in time to avoid any inconvenience.

Furthermore, concerned Invigilators deployed by the Supervisors for such duty may ensure that the above instructions issued to the candidates are followed by the candidates strictly. Any laxity on part of the invigilation staff shall be viewed seriously.
