Subject: Issuance of Admit Cards to the candidates for Physical Standards Test (PST) and Physical Endurance Test (PET) for the posts of Inspector (FPF), Wildlife Guard, FPF Guard, Field Assistant and Social Forestry Worker advertised vide Notification No. 03 of 2021 and 04 of 2022, Item Nos. 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 185, 186, 189, 190, 592, 593, 594, 605 & 606 in the Department of Forest, Ecology & Environment.

The J&K Services Selection Board (JKSSB) conducted OMR based written examination for the post of Inspector (FPF), Wildlife Guard, FPF Guard, Field Assistant and Social Forestry worker, Department of Forest, Ecology & Environment, advertised vide Notification No. 03 of 2021 and 04 of 2022, Item Nos. 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 185, 186, 189, 190, 592, 593, 594, 605 & 606.

The result/score sheet for the examination for the Inspector (FPF), Wildlife Guard, FPF Guard and Field Assistant, Social Forestry worker was notified vide Notification No. JKSSB-COE0EXAM (UT)/14/ 2026-03 (7842028), dated: 28.04.2026 and 11.6.2026 respectively.

Vide Notice No. JKSSB-COE0EXAM(UT)/14/2026-03 (7842028) dated 29-07-2026, the candidates for various posts of the Department of Forest, Ecology & Environment were shortlisted based on merit for appearing in the Physical Standard Test (PST) and Physical Endurance Test (PET).

Now, the J&K Services Selection Board is scheduled to conduct the Physical Standards Test (PST) and Physical Endurance Test (PET) for the above-mentioned posts from 07.09.2026 to 08.09.2026 at Srinagar and from 11.09.2026 to 13.09.2026 at Jammu.

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Candidates can download their Admit Cards for the same from the JKSSB's Official website (www.jkssb.nic.in) w.e.f. **02.09.2026** using their credentials. They must read the instructions contained therein carefully. However, in case a candidate is not able to download his/her admit card, he or she may represent before the board two days before the Examination Date with valid proof of having filled in the online application form and online fee, failing which it shall be presumed that they are not interested in appearing in the said examination and no claim whatsoever shall be entertained.

Stepwise procedure to download JKSSB E-Admit Card:

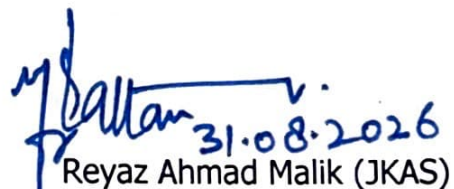
- i. To download E-Admit Card, first visit the official website of JKSSB, i.e. **www.jkssb.nic.in**
- ii. On the homepage, there will be a link to download **E-Admit Card**.
- iii. Enter log-in credentials, i.e. **E-mail ID and Date of Birth**.
- iv. Username will be your **E-mail ID** & Password will be your **DOB in DDMMYYYY** format.
- v. Click on the **"View and Print E-Admit Card"** button.
- vi. Download and print your JKSSB Admit Card.
- vii. **Candidate must bring the clear printed copy of E-Admit card on the day of examination.**

Candidates are further informed and advised to strictly adhere to the following instructions:

- **Candidates are advised to report to their respective centre for Physical Standard Test (PST) and Physical Endurance Test (PET) on the scheduled date/time/venue.**
- **Only those candidates who fulfil the prescribed physical standards (PST) will be required/eligible to undergo the Physical Endurance Test (PET). Mere issuance or downloading of the Admit Card for PST shall not confer any right or eligibility to appear in the PET.**
- **Before commencement of the PET, every candidate shall be required to submit a Physical Fitness Certificate issued by the concerned Chief Medical Officer (CMO). No candidate shall be permitted to participate in the PET without submission of the requisite Physical Fitness Certificate.**

- Candidates participating in the PET may carry **water bottles, juices, electrolyte drinks/ORS, light snacks and other necessary eatables** for personal consumption. Such items shall be carried **in a backpack/bag** and shall be subject to security/venue regulations.
- **Mobile phones and other electronic devices shall not be permitted at the PET venue.**
- Candidates are advised to come adequately prepared for the physical tests and to make appropriate arrangements for hydration and personal requirements, keeping in view the nature and duration of the PET.
- Candidates are advised to take a printout of the Admit Card well in advance to avoid any last-minute rush.
- The candidature of candidates claiming eligibility by misrepresentation/concealment of any material facts, impersonation, fraud, etc. shall be liable for cancellation and disciplinary action, as deemed appropriate.
- The Board reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any stage at which he/she is found ineligible.
- The candidates are also advised to be in touch with the JKSSB's Official Website (**www.jkssb.nic.in**) for the latest updates on the examinations and Admit cards will not be sent by post.

Candidates shall have to submit their Admit Cards back to the Invigilation staff duly signed by the candidate and the concerned Invigilator on the day of the PST/PET.
