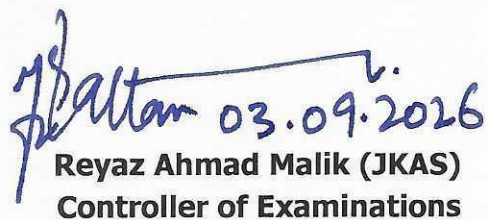
Subject: Important Instructions for Candidates appearing in Physical Standard Test(PST)/Physical Endurance Test(PET) for various posts of Forest Department.

The candidates scheduled to participate in the Physical Standard Test (PST) and Physical Endurance Test (PET) being conducted by the J&K Services Selection Board for various posts of the Forest Department from 07.09.2026 to 13.09.2026, are hereby informed through this notice to follow the following important instructions:

1. The Physical Standard Test (PST) of all the shortlisted candidates who are appearing in Kashmir shall be conducted on 07.09.2026 at **Government Boys Higher Secondary School Jawahar Nagar Srinagar** and Physical Endurance Test (PET) of such candidates who qualify the PST shall be conducted on 08.09.2026 at **Ring Road Wathora Chadoora Budgam**. The Physical Standard Test (PST) of those candidates who are appearing in Jammu shall be conducted on 11.09.2026 at **J&K Services Selection Board, Central Office Akhnoor Road, Muthi Jammu** and Physical Endurance Test (PET) of those candidates who qualify the PST shall be conducted from 12.09.2026 to 13.09.2026 at **Domana New Bypass Road Jammu**. Candidates are required to report the venue strictly as per the date, time and venue mentioned in their Admit Card.
2. Candidates shall report at the designated venue for PET between 5:30 AM and 7:00 AM on the date of test mentioned in their Admit Card. No Candidate shall be permitted entry into the venue after 7:00 AM under any circumstances. Candidates are therefore, advised to reach the venue well before the closing time to allow sufficient time for verification and other pre-test formalities.
3. Candidates may carry snacks, eatables and other light food items for their personal consumption. However, such items shall not be permitted beyond the designated Start Point of the PET track. Cloak room facilities shall be made available at the designated venue(s) for candidates to keep their personal belongings. Candidates are advised to avoid carrying valuables and unnecessary items to the venue. The Board shall not be responsible for loss or damage to any personal belongings.

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4. For the convenience of candidates appearing for the PET in Jammu, the JKSSB shall arrange shuttle bus services from the designated Start Point on the Akhnoor-Samba Ring Road to the PET Test Site. Shuttle bus services shall also be arranged for candidates for appearing in PET in Kashmir Division, from the JKSSB Central office, at ZamZam Complex Rambagh Srinagar to the Test Site at Ring Road Wathora Chadoora Budgam. The last bus shall be leaving the designated spots at Jammu as well at Srinagar before 6:15 AM.
5. The JKSSB shall make arrangements for drinking water and ORS at designated points along the PET track to facilitate candidates during the test.
6. Candidates shall be permitted to carry their own drinking water in a transparent bottle during the PET. The bottle must be transparent and should be meant strictly for personal consumption.
7. Candidates are advised to report well in advance of the prescribed reporting time, follow the instructions of the officials deployed at the venue strictly.
8. Candidates are further advised to carefully read the instructions contained in their Admit Card and comply with all instructions issued by the Board from time to time.
